Active Ingredient: Deflazacort

Dosage Form; Route: Suspension; oral

Recommended Studies: Two studies

1. Type of study: Fasting

Design: Single-dose, two-way crossover in-vivo

Strength: 22.75 mg/mL at the dose of 36.4 mg/1.6 mL

Subjects: Males and non-pregnant, non-lactating females, general population.

Additional Comments: Please follow the preparation and administration instructions in

the approved drug label.

2. Type of study: Fed

Design: Single-dose, two-way crossover in-vivo

Strength: 22.75 mg/mL at the dose of 36.4 mg/1.6 mL

Subjects: Males and non-pregnant, non-lactating females, general population.

Additional Comments: See comment above.

Analyte to measure (in appropriate biological fluid): 21-desacetyldeflazacort (active metabolite) in plasma

Bioequivalence based on (90% CI): 21-desacetyldeflazacort

Waiver request of in-vivo testing: Not Applicable
